We are also very excited to announce the spectacular 2016-2017 Academy season! First up for the Fall will be Mark Twain's American classic, **The Adventures of Huckleberry Finn**. This classic play is the story of a boy's journey with a runaway slave as they make their way down the Mississippi river. Huck, a rebel at heart, is escaping from starched collars, civilization and the drunken rages of his Pap. Jim is seeking life as a free man in the Northern states. 
