

Academy Spotlight

The Academy's Spring semester has started and we are hitting the ground running. We have been working hard on a great new outreach program as well as gearing up for another fun musical!



This month, we are excited to be partnering with Palace Coffee on a great give back aspect of their company called "Kindness is the Cause" where they help 4 different non-profits a year. ALT Academy is their first non-profit and we are doing several different projects with them including the Cause Latte this month and next. The newest addition occurs this month and I am really excited for it! We will be hosting a free theatre workshop for middle school aged students at ALT. We are naming it "An Act of Kindness" Theatre Workshop. We will be hosting kids in 6th-8th grade at ALT on Saturday, February 23rd from 9:00 am to 4:00 pm. Our goal is to offer a free theatre workshop to students who might not be able to afford an extra circular theatre class or to someone who might not have the means to drive to ALT once a week for a class. Our day will include workshops with 4 different aspects of theatre: Acting, Costumes, Hair/Makeup and Set Design. We will rotate each station learning aspects of the theatre from instructors in the morning and then in the afternoon, rehearse a show that they will be putting on that day at 4pm for their families and friends. We are hoping to have 30 students from all over Amarillo and will provide breakfast and lunch for these kids. Again, this will be a FREE Theatre workshop for students. As you can see, I am very excited about this

In January, the Academy held auditions for our upcoming musical *HONK!* and what an abundance of talent showed up! 
