Director's Notes

Hello to all of our wonderful patrons and friends. This is ALT's first Curtain Call newsletter of the new season. I don't know about you, but I think the year 2020 has sucked pretty bad. In my notes in February's Curtain Call, which was announcing the opening of **Peter and the Starcatcher**, I wrote the following:



It is such a great time to be involved at ALT! We are setting records for attendance, season ticket sales and contributions. In fact, I am going to shorten this version of Director's Notes so that we can publish a list of the contributors to the "End of Year" campaign. Our most recent production of Ken Ludwig's Baskerville was a huge success for ALT. We posted 85% attendance for the run.

That seems like a lifetime ago. Just a little less than 7 months ago I was joyous over the success of ALT as we were on our way to completing the most successful season in our history. Life can change in an instant...... I used that phrase several years ago when I was diagnosed with Parkinson's Disease. The recent events in our country, our world, have reminded me again how true that statement really is. I can safely say that I've learned that lesson and I would be happy to not ever repeat it again.

In my 30 something years here at ALT, I have **NEVER** worried or even casually considered that ALT might someday close its doors. During the last few months it's all I can think about. We just recently approved our annual budget, which is projecting a \$164,000 shortfall. That's about 15% of our total budget.

I can't allow this to happen on my watch. WE, the ALT board of directors, staff and volunteers are going to turn this ship around and head for calmer waters. We are producing theatre again, which is bringing in some much needed income. I believe that the Coronavirus and many of its problems will be a part of our lives for a long time. Therefore, I think to survive, we must learn to deal with it and go about our business. We have established safety protocols for both venues, our Academy classes as well as for our casts and crews backstage. WE are paying attention to every detail and not pushing the boundaries of what is appropriate for our customer's safety. We had a very successful run of **The Humans** at the Adventure Space in August AND we had zero problems with anyone contacting the virus as a result of attending the theatre.

WE are opening our Mainstage season in just a few weeks with **The Curious Incident of the Dog in the Night-Time**. This play is simply brilliant. It is funny, intense, heartwarming, inspirational and very entertaining. We will have 200 seats available for each performance from a total of 453. This will allow for plenty of social distancing.

Folks, it's time to start living again. I want to encourage you to purchase your tickets for **The Curious Incident......** It will be the best night you have had in a long time. AND, I promise that we will do our best to keep you safe!

Our community, our state, our country, HELL our world needs a big dose of what ALT provides. We will nurture your soul! I look forward to seeing you at the theatre(s).

fast as we are already selling out shows. We will be following our ALT Adventure Space CoVid Safety protocols and patrons can easily find those and other protocols on our ALT website.


