  from Audition packet on the Academy website before auditions. Do not come to auditions without
  these already filled out!!! There will not be any forms at the auditions.
- Students auditioning should dress in appropriate attire for an audition. Look nice and be able to move. There will not be time to change at the auditions. Face masks/coverings will be required when at ALT.

#### VOCAL AUDITIONS

- Auditions will consist of a prepared vocal selection not to exceed 45 seconds for 5 year olds 7<sup>th</sup> graders and 60 seconds for 8<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> graders.
- Vocal audition piece should be from a musical or similar style of show. DO NOT SING A SONG FROM THE SHOW!
- A speaker with an iPhone jack will be available. Please have music downloaded and not streamed from YouTube, Spotify, Internet, etc... You may sing acapella. An accompanist will NOT be provided.
