- Students auditioning should dress in appropriate attire for an audition. Look nice and be able to move as there will only be time to change into dance shoes before the dance portion of auditions. Face masks/coverings will be highly encouraged when at ALT but will be removed during the vocal audition.

VOCAL AUDITIONS

- Auditions will consist of a prepared vocal selection not to exceed 45 seconds for 5-year-olds 7^{th} graders and 60 seconds for 8^{th} 12^{th} graders.
- Audition piece should be from a musical or similar style of show. DO NOT SING A SONG FROM THE SHOW!
- Please have music downloaded, not streamed, from YouTube, Spotify, or the Internet. An accompanist will NOT be provided.
