Characters

- Margot Wendice female presenting, 35-55, generic American accent. Margot is a strong, intelligent, and beautiful woman. She tends toward caution and convention. Her unfulfilling marriage to Tony led to her brief affair with Maxine.
- Maxine "Max" Hadley female presenting, 35-55, BBC British accent. Maxine is a successful writer of thriller novels. She has a bold and daring personality and is not afraid to spurn conventional roles and expectations.
- Tony Wendice male presenting, 35-55, BBC British accent. Handsome, charming, calculating and vengeful. Tony married Margot for her sizeable inheritance and isn't about to give up the lifestyle to which he has become accustomed. He is a failed writer who now works in the company that publishes Maxine's novels.
- Lesgate male presenting, 35-55, any British accent. A thief, con artist, and possible murderer, Lesgate was a fellow student with Tony at Cambridge. Tony blackmails him into agreeing to kill Margot.
- Inspector Hubbard male presenting, 35-55, any British accent. Inspector Hubbard is a thoughtful and thorough detective who doesn't miss a detail.

BBC BRITISH ACCENT

A non-regional British accent associated with educated speakers and formal speech.

REGARDING AGES

Ages are how the character will be perceived and not necessarily the age of the actor.

STYLE

We will approach this production in the style of film noir. This will call for a dark and stylized portrayal of characters. It would be a good idea to bring this approach into your auditions. There will be smoking in this production. There is a female-on-female kiss that will be handled thoughtfully in rehearsal through common intimacy coordination practices.

AUDITIONS

Auditions will consist of readings from the script sides. Sides will be provided by the director once the auditions start.

Welcome to ALT! We are so glad to have you on the team here at our *community* theatre. The following are some general behavioral guidelines that our volunteers acknowledge in order to make this space safe, supportive, fun and enjoyable for everyone. Again, we are glad you are here!

The following behaviors are strictly prohibited:

- Abusive language, violence or threats toward a staff member, other volunteers, or the public
- · Possession or use of illegal drugs or other substances while volunteering at ALT
- · Theft of money or unethical use of any ALT property or resources
- · Bringing weapons, explosives, or similar items onto the property unless properly authorized
- · Discourtesy, disrespect, or rudeness to staff, fellow volunteers, or any member of the public
- Verbal, physical, visual, or emotional abuse of another participant, staff, or member of the public
- Comments, jokes, or language that is sexually or otherwise harassing to another volunteer or to a staff member of ALT
- · Conduct endangering the life, safety, health or well-being of others
- · Bullying or taking unfair advantage of another participant
- · Failing to cooperate with ALT Staff, Board Members, or others in leadership
- Engaging in conduct detrimental to the organization, subversive conduct, or actions which undermine the organization

In short:

I will ensure that I interact respectfully with ALT Staff, students, volunteers, and the public without regard to age, gender identity, religion, ethnicity, sexual orientation, or any other commonly protected characteristic.

RELEASE AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY, ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT

IN CONSIDERATION OF BEING PERMITTED TO PARTICIPATE IN ANY WAY IN AN AMARILLO LITTLE THEATRE OR ALT ACADEMY ACTIVITY ("ACTIVITY") I, FOR MYSELF, FOR PERSONAL REPRESENTATIVES, ASSIGNS, HEIRS, AND NEXT OF KIN:

1. ACKNOWLEDGE, AGREE, AND REPRESENT THAT I UNDERSTAND THE NATURE OF AMARILLO LITTLE THEATRE AND ALT ACADEMY ACTIVITIES AND THAT I AM QUALIFIED, IN GOOD HEALTH, AND IN PROPER PHYSICAL CONDITION TO PARTICIPATE IN SUCH ACTIVITY.
