Director's Notes



Our 97th season has started and we are gearing up for another fantastic year here at ALT. I am so excited for this season! We truly have something for everyone. To think that ALT has been providing quality theatre to our area since 1927 is remarkable! I am so proud of the work we are doing and am thankful for those who have helped get ALT to where it is today!

I must give a huge congratulations to **Harrison Stringer** and our fabulous Academy for an amazing production of **The Lightning Thief: The Percy Jackson Musical.** What a show! All involved should be very proud. From the innovative set to the powerhouse vocals, this show certainly set the standard for our season! If you missed it, I am sorry for you. You missed one great show!

As you read this article, the play *The Drowning Girls* has just opened at the Adventure Space. This brilliant show was expertly directed by **Jo Smith** and fantastic performances have been turned in by the cast. *The Drowning Girls* was on our radar for a few years and I am so glad we are finally producing it. The tragic true story of these three women who suffered a horrible fate all told in and out of the bathtubs is captivating. If you have yet to see this show, I hope you are able to catch it before it closes on August 25th.

For my article this month, I thought I would take a moment to share some important information with you. Did you know that even with sold-out performances, 60 percent of what it takes to produce the high quality and ambitious works we do here at ALT is funded by contributions from our community of donors? Sadly, those contributions have slowly been on a decline for the past 5 years. This is not good news. We are doing everything we can to still produce the high caliber of shows for our community, but it is getting tougher and tougher each season with the price of so many things going up and the amount of donations going down. I am at a loss as to why, seeing as how our season of shows have included stellar productions! From getting exclusive early rights to shows like **Waitress** and **Beautiful** to laugh-out-loud comedies like **Clue** and **The Play That Goes Wrong**, audiences seem to be loving what we are doing. But what about our donors?

Let me give you a shocking example. Did you know that just 10 years ago, our Producers' Circle group was over 100 members? "What is the Producers' Circle?" you might ask. This is a group of members who dedicate giving ALT an annual donation of \$500 a year with a three-year commitment. This amount can even be drafted monthly for about \$42 each month. Ten years ago, this line item was over \$50,000 in contributions. This year, we are starting the season with 32 members for \$16,000 in donations. That \$34,000 loss has a huge impact on what we can do at ALT. This is just one example of where we are hurting with our decline of donations.

I have to ask... is it me? Is what I am doing as your Managing/Artistic Director keeping you away as a donor? If it is, I need to know. Please feel free to contact me so I can understand what I am doing to keep you, as a donor, away. We were so lucky that Allen Shankles worked so hard to build up a long list of trusted, couples and businesses that he could contact yearly to donate to ALT. Sadly, only a handful of those donors have stayed with ALT after his passing. This is certainly discouraging but my hope is to rebuild our donors list and get ALT back to where we once were with our budget. I know we can do it but I need YOUR help!

In celebration of our 2024/25 season, I am inviting you to become a donor with a contribution of \$24.25.



I'd also like to thank our Production Assistant, **Maddox Nite**, and Assistant Music Director, **Cameron Parrack**, for their countless hours of support for the cast crew and production team. The set -designed by **Tana Roberson** and built by our production team, **Noah Lang**, **Brandon Khamphoumy** and **Michael Villarreal** - put audiences in the heart of Camp Half-Blood and made this truly immersive production soar. **Noah Lang**'s lighting design added a bolt of energy to this already rocking show. **Hunter Lee** served as costume coordinator, mixing fantasy and reality beautifully, and our Prop Designers, **Teri** and **Terry Stringer** turned everyday items into mythic beasts. As always, the **ALT Staff** and **Board of Directors** provided invaluable support. This inspiring cast of 25 teenagers brought the house down with every single performance. The buzz (pun intended) around this show even led to us adding a performance due to our entirely sold out run. This excellent showcase of our Academy's talent reminded us that the things that make us special are the very things that make us strong. I believe everyone who gathered around the campfire with us this summer will remember this experience for a long time.

We are certainly not slowing down as class registration for the Fall opened this week! Classes begin **August 26th**! With classes from ages 3 to 103, there is absolutely something for everyone here at the Academy. I'm especially excited that we are now offering a buy-one-gift-one program for our classes this year.
