## Characters

### • DEENA JONES: (African American, Female presenting, Age 20s-30s)

Initially modest backup singer for The Dreamettes, turned lead singer of The Dreams. An endearing ingenue with regality, grace, and quiet confidence. Her humble beginnings make her an unsuspected underdog. As the lead singer, she is magnetic, effortless and effervescent. Replaces her best friend, Effie under pressure. Embodies both innocence and star power. Mezzo, big full belt voice.

### • EFFIE MELODY WHITE: (African American, Female presenting, Age 20s-30s)

Vibrant young woman who is as oversized in talent as she is in person. Lead Singer of The Dreamettes. A powerhouse and a soaring singer with undeniable talent. The true underdog. A vibrant, confident and outspoken young woman who wears her heart of gold on her sleeve. Becomes overcome with anger, jealousy and paranoia when Curtis betrays her trust. Her journey from snappy confidence to depths of betrayal ultimately ends in triumph. Effie should be full-figured, and her size carries with it a true sense of sexuality. Must have a huge gospel belt voice.

### • LORRELL ROBINSON: (African American, Female presenting, Age 20s-30s)

The group's youngest member. Bubbly, energetic, youthful and pragmatic. Eager for success, she's swept off her feet by the married James Thunder Early. Speaks her mind. A high-energy, quirky, hopeless romantic. Has a keen sense of humor and comedic skill. Soprano, on top of most triad harmony, big full belt voice.

### • C.C. WHITE: (African American, Male presenting, Age 20s)

Effie's songwriting younger brother. Idealistic, loyal, endearing and soft-spoken. While initially inspired by Curtis's business savvy, his efforts to do the right thing are ultimately eclipsed by Curtis' controlling vision. Goes through the journey of losing and regaining himself.

### MICHELLE MORRIS: (African American, Female presenting, Age 20s-30s)

Replacement for Effie. A Dynamic singer/performer that better fits into Curtis' aesthetic for The Dreams. Headstrong and sure of her place. Falls in love with C.C. and facilitates the reunion of him and his sister, Effie.

#### JAMES THUNDER EARLY: (African American, Male presenting, Age 30s - 40s)

Self-proclaimed King of Soul. A chart-topping and dynamic performer. A sexy, high-energy star full of flash, charisma and pizazz. Once a trendsetter, the newer trends threaten to pass him by. A deeply troubled showman of the era, who lets loose in every aspect of his life.

### CURTIS TAYLOR JR: (African American, Male presenting, Age 20s - 40s)

Former Cadillac dealer turned entertainment manager, turned music mogul. Charming, funny, handsome, smooth and seductive but ruthless in the pursuit of his dreams. He is motivated by his hunger for mainstream success, an appreciation for crossover music and keen business mind. Takes over the management of Jimmy Early's career and oversees the rise to stardom of The Dreams. Initially warm and approachable, he becomes hardened by wealth, power and control.

### MARTY: (African American, Male presenting, Age 40s-60s)

NON-SINGING. Street savvy, long-time manager of Jimmy's career and the one to clean up after his mistakes. Represents an earlier age of African American entertainment; honest and loyal, never overstepping his bounds. At odds with Curtis and his ideas and schemes. Later oversees Effie's comeback.

 DAVE (White, Male presenting, Age 20s-30s) and the SWEETHEARTS (2 White, female presenting, AGE 20S-30S)

Cadillac Car soloist. Lead singer of Dave and The Sweethearts. "All American" pop singer of the 1960s. Covers Jimmy Early and the Dreamettes' 'Cadillac Car' and steals their thunder.

 ENSEMBLE OF EXCELLENT SINGER / DANCERS: (Males, Females, Any Ages, Any Ethnicity)

Singer/Dancers for various supporting roles: strong singers who move very well. All possess unique and vivid personalities and have the ability to play a wide variety of characters including Tiny Joe Dixon, Dave & the Sweethearts, The Stepp Sisters, The Tuxedos, Charlene, Joann, M.C., Stage Manager, Little Albert, Mr. Morgan, The Tru-Tones, Dwight, fans, reporters, stagehands, party guests, photographers, film executives, etc.

### **FORMS**

You will need to bring these completed forms to your audition. <u>If you have already turned in a code of conduct and waiver this season, you do not need to turn in another one</u>.

### **VOCAL AUDITIONS**

Those auditioning should prepare a vocal audition not exceeding 60 seconds. Sing a song in the style of the show or a song that you think shows your singing voice off the best (R&B, Gospell, etc...) A speaker with a phone jack will be available if you have recorded music or a track. Please have music downloaded and not streamed from YouTube, Spotify, Internet, etc... You may also sing a capella. An accompanist will not be provided for this audition.

### DANCE AUDITIONS

A dance combination will be taught at the auditions for anyone interested in a role that requires dancing. There will be no YouTube video prior to this audition.

### **CALLBACKS**

After auditions have concluded, the directors will determine who is needed for callbacks. Singing songs from the show and cold readings from the script can be expected. Callbacks will be by directors invitation only. A callback list will be posted on ALT's homepage at Noon on Wednesday, 3/5/25. Please note that not every character will require a callback. Not receiving a callback does not necessarily mean you will not be cast, nor does receiving a callback guarantee you will be cast.

The following behaviors are strictly prohibited:

- Abusive language, violence or threats toward a staff member, other volunteers, or the public
- Possession or use of illegal drugs or other substances while volunteering at ALT
- Theft of money or unethical use of any ALT property or resources
- Bringing weapons, explosives, or similar items onto the property unless properly authorized
- Discourtesy, disrespect, or rudeness to staff, fellow volunteers, or any member of the public
- Verbal, physical, visual, or emotional abuse of another participant, staff, or member of the public
- Comments, jokes, or language that is sexually or otherwise harassing to another volunteer or to a staff member of ALT
- · Conduct endangering the life, safety, health or well-being of others
- Bullying or taking unfair advantage of another participant
- · Failing to cooperate with ALT Staff, Board Members, or others in leadership
- Engaging in conduct detrimental to the organization, subversive conduct, or actions which undermine the organization

#### In short:
