

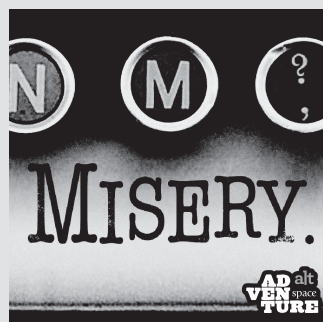

Everyone involved should be incredibly proud. From the inventive choreography to the powerhouse vocals, this production set a high bar for the rest of our season. If you missed it, I am sorry.
